


From your home screen, tap the settings app to open it. The settings app is the first app in the third row of your home screen. It is a gray square with dark grey circles in it.




Once you are in settings, scroll until you find Touch ID & Passcode. It will have a red fingerprint icon. Tap this to open an new page.





Before proceeding, you will need to enter the passcode that unlocks the phone. It is a six digit code that you were provided with. Tap the numbers on the keypad that appears to enter the code.



Now you are in the Touch ID & Passcode page. To add your fingerprint to touch id, tap Add a Fingerprint. It is blue text.



Follow the instructions on the screen to set up your fingerprint for Touch ID




Place and Lift your finger flat on the home button as prompted by the instructions. You will have to do this multiple times.




Adjust Your Grip

Keep going to capture the edges of your print.



Tap the blue Continue button on the bottom of the screen. Now you will need to lift and place all the edges of your finger on the home button.



It will tell you when you have completely configured the fingerprint. Tap the blue Continue button on the bottom of the screen.



Now that you have completed setting up your fingerprint for Touch ID, you will not need to input a passcode when opening your phone with that finger. Leave iPhone Unlock on. Options turned on will show in green, options turned off or uneditable will be grey.
